GENERAL ORDER

Recognizing that a significant number of violations of the terms of federal supervised release and probation are linked to the abuse of illegal and prescription drugs, the Court hereby establishes a Court-Assisted Recovery Effort Program (CARE) for qualified individuals on federal post-conviction supervision. The CARE program (a collaborative effort of this Court, the United States Probation Office, the Federal Public Defender's Office, and the United States Attorney's Office) will provide court-assisted supervision of qualified individuals who volunteer to participate in the program. The program is designed to implement research-based practices to enhance each participant's opportunity for sustained recovery from substance abuse and successful re-entry into the community as a sober, employed and law-abiding citizen. The detailed requirements of the program are set out in a separate document maintained by the Probation Office.
