ORDER

Effective April 25, 2016, all Western District of Oklahoma Criminal Justice Act (“CJA”) vouchers must be prepared and submitted electronically via eVoucher. eVoucher is a nationally-supported, web-based solution for the preparation, submission, monitoring, and approval of CJA vouchers. Beginning April 25, 2016, no voucher will be approved or paid unless it is submitted via eVoucher.


As the eVoucher system is not compatible with the system currently used by CJA Panel attorneys to submit vouchers, the Court will permit counsel to submit, without prior court order, interim voucher for time and expenses incurred in a case as long as the interim voucher is submitted no later than **April 15, 2016**. All time and expenses thereafter must be submitted via eVoucher.

The Court has determined that training on the mandatory eVoucher system should be required and therefore directs all persons currently serving on the CJA panel to attend eVoucher training arranged by the CJA Panel Administrator. Classes have been scheduled for April 20, 2016 and April 21, 2016 at the William J. Holloway, Jr. United States Courthouse in Oklahoma City and April 28, 2016 at the United States Courthouse in Lawton.

Attorneys who fail to attend eVoucher training will be subject to dismissal from the CJA Panel.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
