ORDER

On April 21, 2020, the Court issued G.O. 20-4.1 suspending in-person proceedings involving persons detained at the Grady County Law Enforcement Center (GCLEC) until May 11, 2020. On May 8, 2020, the Court extended the suspension until June 1, 2020. In light of current conditions at GCLEC and after consultation with the United States Marshal, the Court extends the suspension period until June 22, 2020. Exceptions to the suspension may be permitted by the presiding judge after consultation with and concurrence of the United States Marshal and the Chief Judge. All other provisions of G.O. 20-4 and G.O. 20-4.1 shall remain in effect until further order of the Court.
