

ORDER

In light of the termination of the COVID-19 public health emergency, the following General Orders are no longer in effect: G.O. 20-4 (filed Mar. 13, 2020); G.O. 20-5 (filed Mar. 13, 2020); G.O. 20-5.1 (filed May 28, 2020); G.O. 20-7 (filed Mar. 16, 2020); G.O. 20-11 (filed Apr. 4, 2020); G.O. 21-10 (filed May 28, 2021); and G.O. 22-2 (filed Mar. 14, 2022).

While persons who enter the courthouses are no longer required to wear face coverings, judges continue to have discretion to require that face coverings be worn in their courtrooms or chambers.
