## **GENERAL ORDER**

The Court hereby establishes the following page limitations for briefs filed in capital habeas cases:

- 1. The petition or opening brief shall be limited to 100 pages, exclusive of accompanying documents;
- 2. The response brief shall be limited to 125 pages, exclusive of accompanying documents;
- 3. The reply brief shall be limited to 25 pages, exclusive of accompanying documents; and
- 4. If the respondent raises affirmative defenses in the response that the petitioner addresses in the reply, the respondent may file a sur-reply to address only those arguments raised in the reply. The sur-reply brief shall be limited to 10 pages, exclusive of accompanying documents.

Except as otherwise specified by the Court, all filings shall conform with the Rules Governing Section 2254 Cases in the United States District Courts, the Local Court Rules, and the Court's ECF Policies & Procedures Manual. Further, incorporating by reference to other briefs or pleadings on file either in this Court or any other Court is disapproved

and does not satisfy the requirements of this Order. The page limitations established herein shall be extended only for good cause shown.

This Order supersedes G.O. 10-1 (filed January 11, 2010).
