
ORDER

IT IS ORDERED, effective immediately, that no member of the public will be permitted to bring food, beverages, or other liquids into any federal courthouse in the Western District of Oklahoma, including the William J. Holloway United States Courthouse, 200 N.W. 4th Street, the United States Post Office and Courthouse, 215 Dean A. McGee Avenue, both in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, or the Lawton Federal Building and U.S. Courthouse, 410 SW 5th St, Lawton, Oklahoma. This rule does not apply to medically necessary foods and liquids or to food and liquids necessary for infants; all food and liquids shall be screened by court security personnel. A judge or court security officer may permit additional exceptions as individual circumstances warrant. This order does not apply to employees of the Judiciary or agencies housed in any courthouse—or to planned events sponsored by the court or resident agencies—to those with valid jury summons, seated members of an active jury, grand jurors, employees of the Federal Public Defender, CJA panel attorneys, United States Attorneys, or law enforcement officers.


Consumption of food and beverages, even those purchased after admission to

any Courthouse, is prohibited in all courtrooms, except as may be specifically allowed by the presiding judge.
